

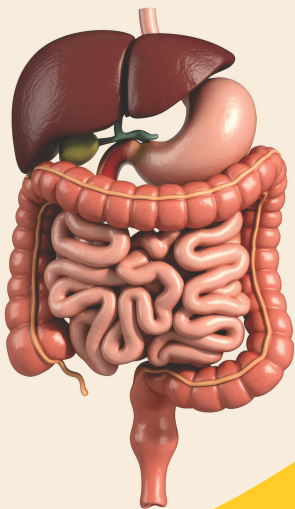

 - ❖ For Original Research: Introduction/Background, Aims & Objectives, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion
 - ❖ For Case Reports/Case Series: Introduction, Case Description/Summary, Discussion, Conclusion
- 4. No tables, images, or references in the abstract text**
- 5. Standard abbreviations only; expand any non-standard abbreviation at first use**

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- ❖ The presenting author must be a registered delegate of KASGOCON 2026.
- ❖ The work must be original and not published or presented elsewhere prior to the conference.
- ❖ Each submission will be acknowledged by email — please provide a valid, active email ID and contact number.
- ❖ The Scientific Committee holds final authority on acceptance and category placement
- ❖ Incomplete or non-compliant submissions may be rejected without notice.

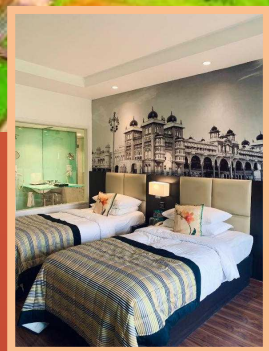
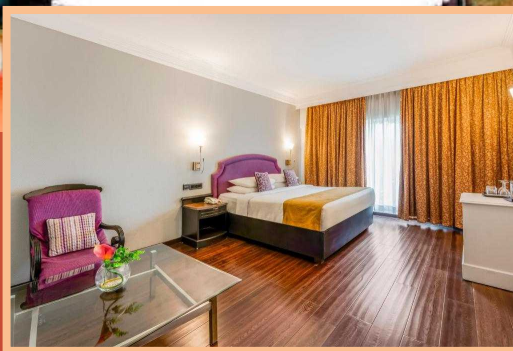
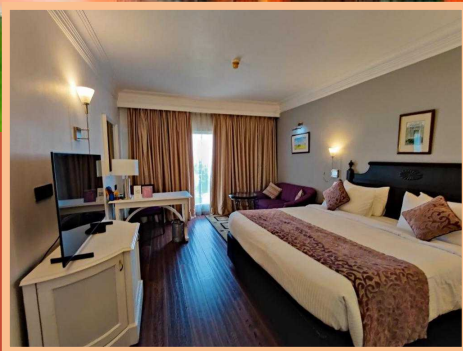
